#### LEGEND

**Ch.** – Chapter in which material appears.

**Item Description** – Description of item being used.

**Full Source Information** – Complete source/reference for the original publication of the material used.

**Copyright Holder** – The publisher, creator or other party who holds copyright to the original material, incl. contact info.

**Date Permission Requested** – Date permission was requested.

**Date Permission Received** – Date stated on permission agreement when permission was granted.

**Print rights/Editions/Use Restrictions** - Indicate if permission has been received, and indicate any specific terms specified on agreement, i.e. World rights; one edition or future editions. Any restrictions, i.e. North American rights instead of World rights, limited quantities, etc. indicated on copyright holder's agreement should be noted and your editor should be notified immediately. **Comments/Status of Request** – This column is for comments regarding the status of your request and also for notes regarding why you believe an item is Fair Use or in the public domain.

**\*\*Required Credit Line** – Write the exact credit line indicated by the Rightsholder. If none has been provided write "**Use Standard Credit Line.**" If the rightsholder has indicated that they do not wish to be credited, write "**Do not credit.**" If no credit line is necessary, write "**N/A.**" All Fair Use items should include some sort of credit to the original source.
